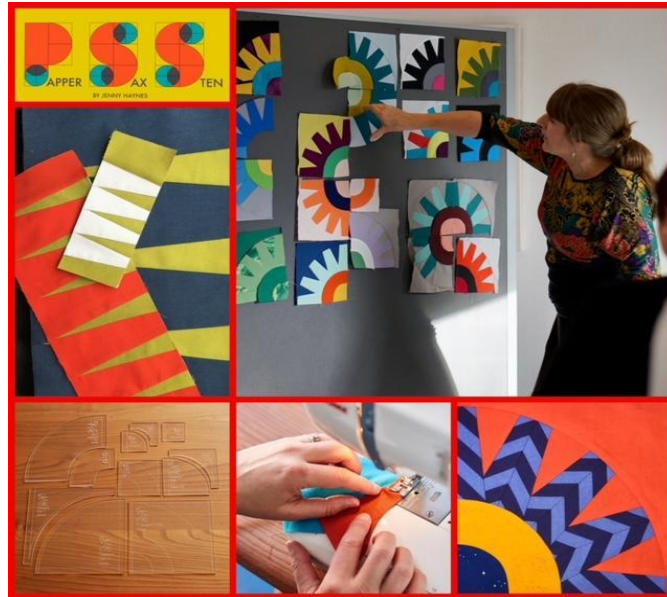


Thistles, Cogs and Caterpillar Wheels:

Jenny Haynes: Papper, Sax, Sten

This is an on-line course consisting of a one-hour 'Get Ready!' session at 2pm ET on October 13th to discuss the pattern, colour, templates and what prep you can do, followed three weeks later by a two-day workshop (1pm to 4pm ET on Saturday 2nd and Sunday 3rd of November). The 'Get Ready!' session and the workshop will be recorded for you to watch again and will sit, together with all the class material, on my teaching platform.

Learning objectives:

In this class I will show you how to make a block I created for the Modern Times Quilt- the classic New York Beauty block but with a twist.

You will learn how the different blocks are designed and put together, the way the different parts can be shifted and moved to change the look of the block.

We will sew no-pin machine-pieced curves in three sizes whilst playing with my *Drunkard's Path Templates, a tool that makes precise blocks that are easy to piece together.

We will also cover all the stages of Foundation Paper Piecing using Freezer Paper- how to prep the paper, what stitch length to use, how best to put the block together and more.

The techniques learnt will give you knowledge and freedom to design your own Cogs Quilt. This is a techniques class and we will not be following a pattern. Off-piste sewing is highly encouraged. Check #thistlescogsandcaterpillarwheels for previous class samples. We will also play with fussy-cut blocks using stripes to create striking effects.

Included:

- PDF paper templates
- Cogs workshop notes
- A recording of the Get ready! session and workshop

Supplies list:

- Sewing machine
- Quality fine sewing thread (40 or 50wt) in neutral or to match your project
- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutter
- Long gridded ruler
- Hera marker (preferred) or other non-permanent marking tool/pen/chalk
- Pins
- Seam ripper
- Access to a printer (for the paper templates) OR my Acrylic templates*
- Freezer paper (a 15" sq or four US letter sized sheets will be enough to get you started)
- Glue stick (I use Prym Aqua Marker but Sewline Glue Pen is popular too), useful but not important
- Add a 1/4 ruler, useful but not important

Level:

Suitable for beginner as well as advanced quilters. No previous curve experience required but general quilting knowledge is assumed (how to use a rotary cutter, sew with an accurate seam allowance etc).

*We will be using the Complete Drunkard's Path set in this class. Add the Complete 14" Drunkard's Path set to that if you want to go large. You can now purchase my templates from my US supplier. Please note: The course includes the paper version (pdf) of the templates to print if you prefer to work with paper.
