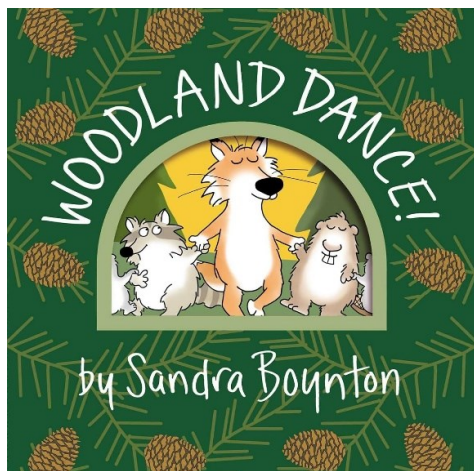
Our completion deadline is the April 2025 MQG meeting. Our guild and your name will be featured on your finished creation.



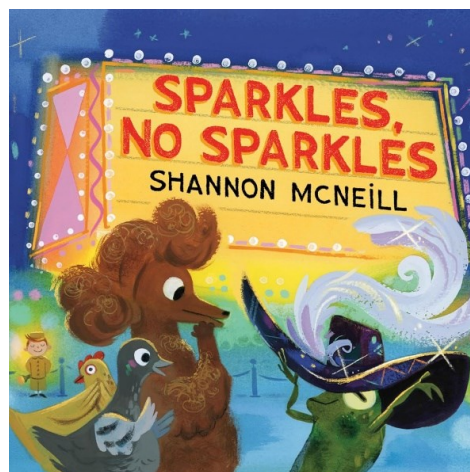
