

Supply List

- **ByAnnie pattern** – **IMPORTANT – Prior to class cut and label all pieces!** Note – the last page of the pattern are labels. It is recommended that you copy the page for size bag you are doing and then use those labels as you cut out your pieces. You may also want to watch the free videos that come with the pattern prior to class.
 - If your pattern includes mesh or vinyl - I recommend that you cut the mesh and/or vinyl pieces slightly larger (1/2 inch in both directions) to give you some leeway.
- **FABRIC AND NOTIONS** – As listed in the pattern you are doing.
- **SEWING MACHINE** – In good working order. Remember your machine manual (recommended in case you need it for reference), presser feet (see list below), power cord, and foot pedal. Be sure to bring the appropriate stitch plate for the presser foot you are using – refer to your machine manual.
 - Recommended feet** (Bernina foot numbers in parentheses)
 - Straight stitch (1/4-inch, patchwork) (1/1C/1D, 34/34C/34D, 37/37D, 57/57D or 97/97D)
 - Overlock (2/2A)
 - Zipper (4/4D)
 - Edgestitch (10/10C/10D) *OR* Piping (38)
 - Walking foot with guides (50)
 - Teflon foot (52/52D, 53, 56) – Highly recommended if you choose to make any pockets with vinyl.
- **THREAD** – A quality sewing thread. Think about whether you want the thread to blend in with your fabric or stand out as a decorative element. There will be areas quilted as well as areas that are just seams holding pieces together so you may want to bring two different color threads.
- **EXTRA BOBBINS** – Always be prepared.
- **SCISSORS** – For snipping threads, etc.
- **MACHINE NEEDLES** – Always best to be prepared in case a needle breaks or becomes dull. Jeans needles tend to work best for this project.
- **PINS** – Straight pins that easily pierce your fabric.
- **FABRIC (WONDER) CLIPS** – A MUST for the bindings of this project. If you are using vinyl, you will need the large wonder clips since you can't use pins with vinyl.
- **MARKING TOOL**
- **SEAM RIPPER**
- **STILETTO** – This will make attaching the binding much easier.
- **BODKIN** – To assist in inserting the strapping
- **QUICK TURN TOOL** – Or other tool for turning fabric tubes right side out after constructing
- **WASHI TAPE** – If you are using vinyl, you will need washi or another tape that won't leave a residue once removed.
- **EMPTY TOLLET PAPER ROLL** – Yes, it sounds strange, but it will come in very handy.
